2nd SUNDAY OF EASTER

Divine Mercy Sunday. In today's Gospel reading, the risen Jesus comes among his disciples. As we gather to celebrate the mystery of Easter in our Eucharist, we remember that the risen Lord is just as present here among us as he was with those first disciples

This week's Gospel is chosen because it relates what happened today: "eight days later" - after Easter Sunday. Jesus came again to his disciples. The story of Thomas's doubt and his faith leads us to think about our own doubts and our faith - but always in the context of being part of the family of the Church into which we are baptised.

Acts 5:12-16: Luke gives us a picture of the early community of disciples in Jerusalem and how people were attracted to come to them for blessing and healing.

<u>Responsorial Psalm</u>: Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, his love is everlasting

Apocalypse 1:9-13. 17-19: John recounts the vision that led to his writing this book, the Apocalypse or Revelation. The risen Jesus speaks to him and commissions him to set down all that he sees regarding the present and the future.

John 20:19-31: The risen Jesus makes himself present to his disciples on two occasions. He commissions them to continue his work. Then Thomas makes the supreme confession of faith.

2021 Synod 2023 For a synodal Church communion | participation | mission

During this time, the entire People of God is invited to reflect on the theme of **"Praying and Walking Together".** The aim of the Synod is "to plant dreams.....allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships.....give strength to our hands". In a spirit of Synodality, of walking together, let us begin in a spirit of prayer, to listen. Any topic can be aired including things like sexuality, liturgy, who can receive Holy Communion, people in irregular unions, social justice, racism, and clericalism.At the same time the Pope emphasises that it is not a parliament or an investigation into opinions, **The three key words are: communion, participation** and **mission**.
