**Luke 14:1. 7-14**: We are blessed if we are prepared to look after the needs of people who are unable to repay us.


# "When you hold a banquet,

### invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind"

Jesus was invited to share the Sabbath meal at the home of a leading Pharisee. Noticing the competition for the seats of honour at table, he used the opportunity to teach a lesson on humility to both host and guest. He suggested that the guests take should the lowest place. If the host moved them up to a higher position, they would be honoured, and they wouldn't be embarrassed by being asked to take a lower position.

Jesus reminded the host not to invite only wealthy and important people to his home; he should open his doors to the weak and powerless who were without earthly power (the *anawim*). Although these poor were in no position to repay their host for his generosity, he would be richly rewarded at the "resurrection of the just"

Can you imagine what it would be like if banquets were held in



honour of the poor and deprived instead of the rich and famous? How would this change us? How would it change the world?

# 10 KEY QUOTES EVERY CATHOLIC SHOULD REFLECT ON:

from Pope Francis' apostolic letter on the liturgy,

### "Desiderio desideravi".

The pope's newest apostolic letter reflects on the meaning of baptism, our understanding of mystery, inadequate liturgical approaches, the art of celebrating the liturgy and more... 'I have longed to eat this Passover with you before I suffer ...'

### 9: The role of the priest

The priest himself should be overpowered by this desire for communion that the Lord has toward each person. It is as if he were placed in the middle between Jesus' burning heart of love and the heart of each of the faithful, which is the object of the Lord's love. To preside at the Eucharist is to be plunged into the furnace of God's love.

### 10: A call to abandon polemics

Let us abandon our polemics to listen together to what the Spirit is saying to the Church. Let us safeguard our communion. **Let us continue to be astonished at the beauty of the Liturgy.** The Paschal Mystery has been given to us. Let us allow ourselves to be embraced by the desire that the Lord continues to have to eat His Passover with us. All this under the gaze of Mary, Mother of the Church.


