During His hidden life in Nazareth, and especially during His public life when He travelled through the towns and villages of Palestine, our Lord met sinners of all kinds. There is not a single record of a harsh word spoken by Him to any of them. In fact, He was accused of mixing too freely with them. His answer was that "it was those who were ill who needed a doctor, not those who were in good health." The sinners He met knew that they were ill. They regretted their sins. He forgave them.

Todays' Readings:

Ecclesiasticus 35: 12-14 16-18: The prayer of the humble pleases the Lord.

Response to the Psalm: This poor man called; the Lord has heard him.

Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18. At my first defence no one appeared on my behalf, but everyone deserted me. May it not be held against them!

Luke 18:9-14: God be merciful to me, a sinner. Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else.

THE DAILY DECALOGUE OF POPE JOHN XXIII (Part Two)

- *Only for today:* I will do one good deed and not tell anyone about it.
- *Only for today*: I will do at least one thing I do not like doing; and if my feelings are hurt, I will make sure that no one notices.
- *Only for today*: I will make a plan for myself, I may not follow it to the letter, but I will make it. And I will be on guard against two evils; hastiness and indecision.
- Only for today: I will firmly believe, despite appearances, that the good Providence of God cares for me as no one else who exists in this world.
- *Only for today*: I will have no fears. In particular, I will not be afraid to enjoy what if beautiful and to believe in goodness. Indeed, for 12 hours, I can certainly do what might cause me consternation; were I to believe I had to do it all my life.
