Response to the Psalm:


With the Lord there is mercy and fulness of redemption.

Romans 8:8-11: Paul focuses on how God's Spirit lives in us.

John 11:1-45: The extraordinary account of the final sign that Jesus gave – the raising of Lazarus from death itself.

"I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live".

Lazarus was dying, and his sisters, Martha and Mary, sent word to Jesus to come immediately to the village of Bethany where they lived. The disciples feared for Jesus' life as the town was near Jerusalem. Knowing his fate awaited him in the Holy City, Jesus declared that God's glory would be revealed so that all might believe. Jesus was delayed in coming, and upon his arrival, Martha told Jesus that he was too late; her brother had already died. Although Martha reproached Jesus for not coming sooner, she was confident that God would grant whatever he asked. Jesus told her that he had power over life and death and asked her if she believed that his words were true. Like Peter, Martha confessed her faith in Jesus as the "Messiah, the Son of God". With a powerful command, he raised Lazarus to life, a symbol of Christ's own resurrection and our rising to new life with him. Ironically, it was this gift of life that would lead to Jesus' own death, which offered salvation to the whole world.

The Liturgy of the Word WE LISTEN THE MASS 3 (of a series)

In the 'Liturgy of the Word' we listen as one – to the **First**

Reading, from the Old Testament or the Acts of the Apostles, to the Second Reading, from the New Testament, and to the Gospel and the Homily, responding in the Psalm, Profession of Faith and Prayer of the Faithful. How do we listen carefully? It can be quite a challenge to listen attentively to all the readings at Mass! We should do our best to listen to the readings, join in the prayers, sing the hymns and take part in the silence as best we can. One good way of preparing is to read the Sunday readings beforehand so that we're ready to hear them in church. St Jerome says that 'Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ'.
