

Todays Readings
Genesis 12:1-4: When God calls Abram, it is a life-changing moment, for he is asked to leave everything that he knows.

Response to the Psalm: May your love be upon us, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you.

2 Timothy 1:8-10: Paul tells Timothy that Jesus brings us the Good News, but following him can come at a price.

Matthew 17:1-9: The wondrous sight of Christ in glory also inspires fear in the apostles.

When Moses renewed the law that he received on Mt. Sinai, a cloud covered the mountain symbolizing God's presence. After forty days and nights, Moses' face had "become radiant while he conversed with the Lord" On Mt. Tabor, at the Transfiguration, a cloud enveloped Jesus and his three companions: Peter, James and John. Jesus became radiant in his "transfiguration" (metamorphosis, a change in outward appearance). Appearing alongside Jesus was Moses the great lawgiver, and Elijah the prophet. Israel had disobeyed God's law and failed to heed the prophet's message. Jesus was God's "beloved Son," the fulfilment of the law and the Prophets. Like Moses the people were commanded to "listen" to Jesus. When the vision was over, the disciples beheld only Jesus.
