SUNDAY 9TH JUNE 2024 10TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

As we gather as the family of God, we give thanks as a community of faith for the grace that renews us every day. Jesus tells us that everyone who does the will of God is his brother and sister and mother.

TODAYS READINGS:

Genesis 3:9-15 – Adam and Eve are tempted in the garden by the serpent.

RESPONSE TO THE PSALM: With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption.

2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1 – We believe that God, who raised the Lord Jesus to life, will raise us with Jesus in our turn, and that there is an everlasting home built by God for us, in the heavens.

Mark 3:20-35 – Jesus tells us that our sins will be forgiven and that everyone who does the will of God is a brother or sister or mother of Jesus.

"Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother".

News of Jesus' ministry reaches members of his family who have got difficulty understanding his lifestyle as

an itinerant preacher. They fear he has lost his mind and cannot handle his own affairs. Some scribes attributed Jesus' power over disease as coming from Beelzebub ('lord of the lofty dwelling,' the pagan god Baal of Syria). Jesus shows the foolishness of a divided kingdom. His every word and deed were an attack on Satan's domain. When Jesus was informed that his mother and relatives were outside looking for him, he said that what makes a person his "brother and sist." Is not just blood relationship, it is in doing God's will. In Semitic languages, "brothers" or "sisters" can mean children of the same parent, but can also imply



extended members of a family such as cousins, and so on. If Mark intended to say that Mary had other children, he would have said, "The sons and daughters of your mother are here," which would explain that they were Jesus' natural brothers and sisters. The doctrine of Mary's perpetual virginity was defined by the Lateran Council in 649 AD.

The Bubbly Club would like to invite any adult parishioners – children welcome if accompanied by adults - to join us on what has previously proved to be a lovely day out on Saturday 10th August 2024. Save the date, details to follow:

CARLO ACUTIS who died of leukaemia in 2006 aged 15 has already been beatified ("called Blessed") and is now to be a Canonised Saint – the first saint of this millennium.

Born in London in 1991. Although an ordinary boy, loving football and all kinds of sports; enjoying his friends and loving animals (devoted to our own St Francis and Assisi) he, from the age of six, became interested in Computers and, at nine started studying computer programming.

A lot of people have saluted his short life as evidence of holiness highlighting his clear love of God, his kindness to other people as well as his dedication to spreading the word of God by designing websites for his school and for his church. He was also known for his love of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and he launched a website just days before his death in which he documented every reported miracle linked to the Eucharist. A miracle attributed to Carlo's intercession, was the curing of a university student in Florence who suffered brain trauma. This miracle has been confirmed as due to the intercession of Carlo so he will be canonised by Pope Francis and among those who will attend the canonization ceremony will be his father Andrea Acutus, his mother Antonio and their twins, a boy and a girl, Michelle and Francesca born after Carlo's death – themselves a bit of a miracle, born when the mother was 44 years old.
