Today is the eleventh Sunday in the Ordinary Time of the Church's year. At this, as at every Mass, Jesus welcomes us to listen his word and to receive him into our hearts.

TODAYS READINGS:

Ezekiel 17:22-24 – In his image of a tree Ezekiel paints us a picture of the Lord who cares for his people and brings them to shelter and safety.


<u>RESPONSE TO THE PSALM</u>: It is good to give you thanks, O Lord.

2 Corinthians **5:6-10** – Paul writes of his longing to be with the Lord and his intention of pleasing him always.

Gospel Mark 4:26-34 – Jesus tells us two parables to show us that for the Kingdom of God great things come from small beginnings.

"With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it".

Jesus taught his followers through parables, stories that illustrated Christian truths using examples from everyday life. The images of farmers, grain, seeds, and plants invited the followers of Jesus to discover the nature of God's reign. Although a farmer did his work in planting the seed, it grew according to its own timetable. Jesus compared the irrepressible nature of the kingdom to a mustard seed that is small when it is sown, but which grew to the height of a great tree when the plant matured. So too the kingdom moves steadily forward toward its fulfilment. Jesus' disciples were



greatly encouraged; their inadequacies would not hinder the coming of the reign of God, which would grow imperceptibly until fully established at the final judgment.

DAY FOR LIFE

The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. In England and Wales, Day for Life is celebrated on the third Sunday of June each year. This year it falls on **16 June**. The theme is The Lord is my Shepherd – Compassion and Hope at the End of Life. A debate on end-of-life issues has been in the headlines in recent months with calls for assisted suicide being expressed, especially by celebrities, a view that opposes the Catholic view that life is a gift and that we are called to care for others at the end of their lives.
