#### SUNDAY 25TH AUGUST 2024 21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The theme that holds the readings together today is faithfulness: faithfulness to God: choosing Jesus and being faithful to him, the one Simon Peter calls "the Holy One of God". If we've that radical commitment to Jesus, although we may sometimes be unfaithful, we know that he is always faithful. Even if we go away, he loves us and gently calls us back to him. Let us come to him now in love and penitence, as we prepare to celebrate his coming to us in this Mass.

#### **TODAYS READINGS:**

Joshua 24:1-2. 15-18 Joshua asks the people to renew choose to serve the Lord always.

### **RESPONSE TO THE PSALM:** Taste and see that the Lord is good.

Ephesians 5:21-32 St Paul speaks about marriage, obedience and fidelity, love and self-sacrifice.

**John 6:60-69** Jesus, like Joshua, calls for his disciples to choose to remain faithful after some had gone away.

## "Lord, to whom can we go? You have the words of eternal life".

Jesus' revelation that he was the "bread of life" (v.48) caused division between those who had faith in him and those who did not. The unbelievers murmured against Jesus' teaching, and some of Jesus' disciples doubted his words. Jesus did not retract his teaching but invited his followers to a deeper faith in this mystery that could only be understood through God's grace. If they could not believe that he was God's Word become flesh, what would they think when he ascended to his Father in glory? Jesus asked the twelve apostles if they too planned to leave him. Peter, the leader of the future Church, confessed his faith in the life-giving words of Jesus. There was no one else to whom he could go. The twelve apostles are mirrors of ourselves, flawed but graced human beings
