SUNDAY 1ST JANUARY 2023 MARY, HOLY MOTHER OF GOD.

Today's Readings

Numbers 6:22-27: We are beloved and blessed by God our Father.

Response to the Psalm: O God, be gracious and bless us.

Galatians 4:4-7: As adopted children of God our Father, we are sisters and brothers in Christ.

Luke 2:16-21: Following the angelic announcement of his birth, the shepherds come to visit the infant Jesus. Mary treasures all these events in her heart.

NEW YEAR'S DAY: Mary, the Holy Mother of God "And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart"

Mary and Joseph obeyed the law of Rome by going to Bethlehem to register for the census. They obeyed the religious law of Israel by having their child circumcised on the eighth day after his birth. In this ceremony, the child entered into the life of the Jewish community and received his name: Jesus (Hebrew: Yeshua, "Yahweh saves"). Jesus' mother Mary was the model disciple who received the Word of God with faith and pondered its meaning in her heart. The Church regards Mary as both the Mother of God and the Mother of the Church. In Genesis 3:15, we have what is known as the "first gospel", God's promise of redemption after the fall of Adam and Eve: "I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed; he shall bruise your head and you shall bruise his heel." The Church sees this as a prophecy of Jesus' victory over the devil on the Cross. Further, Eve is also described as "the mother of all the living". Through grace—in Christ—Mary becomes our mother; the mother of all the living not in the order of nature, but in the order of supernatural grace.
