TODAYS READINGS:

1st Reading: Genesis 2:18-24 - God creates woman from

Adam's rib.

RESPONSE TO THE PSALM: May the Lord bless us all the days of our life.

2nd Reading: Hebrews 2:9-11 - Christ was made perfect through suffering so that we might all be consecrated

Gospel: Mark 10:2-16 - Jesus teaches against divorce and welcomes the children.

Mark's Gospel puts the issue of the value of marriage and of the care for children side by side with each other. In the Gospel passage, Jesus explained God's divine intention for man and woman who decide to enter in marriage – that they shall become one body (cf. Gen. 2:24). The certificate of dismissal in order to divorce (cf. Dt. 24:1-4) was allowed by Moses due to the stubbornness of the people. Moreover, Jesus showed how much he would care for the little children. In every broken marriage, the first ones to suffer are the children. Undoubtedly, Jesus placed so much importance on family life.
