Pope Francis, as well as many scientists, politicians and activists, has frequently reminded us of the dangers facing our planet through climate change. To use his word: "our Sister, Mother Earth cries out to us because of the harm we have inflicted on her by our irresponsible use and abuse of the goods with which God has endowed her". He echoes the call of Jesus for a simpler lifestyle

### **Today's Readings**

**Wisdom 9:13-18:** Human reasoning is unsure, but Wisdom, the light of the Holy Spirit, teaches us what pleases God.

RESPONSE TO THE PSALM: O Lord, You have been our refuge

from one generation to the next.

**Philemon 9-10. 12-17:** St Paul speaks about Onesimus, a runaway slave whom he converted to Christianity; he asks his master to take him back not as a slave any more but as a "dear brother".

**Luke 14:25-33:** Jesus commends a radical life without possessions and human ties, providing we weigh up the costs.

Jesus used two examples to explain the need to be prepared.



- 1. Before a builder could begin construction, he must make an assessment of his materials; otherwise, he might not be able to complete the job.
- 2. A ruler should weigh the strength of his army before going into battle, or else he might be defeated. Only people who were fully prepared would be able to follow Jesus to the cross that awaited him.

#### LIST OF APOSTLES IN THE GOSPELS AND ACT

There are three lists of the different in order.

Matthew: First, Simon, also known as Peter, and his brother Andrew; James

son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip; Bartholomew; Thomas; Matthew the tax collector;

James son of Alphaeus; Thaddaeus; Simon the Zealot, and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed him.

Mark: Simon (to whom he gave the name Peter); James son of Zebedee and John the brother of James (to

whom he gave the name Boanerges, that is, Sons of Thunder); Andrew; Philip; There are three lists of the Twelve in the Synoptic Gospels and one in the Acts of the Apostles. Each list is different in

order.

**Luke:** Simon, whom he named Peter, and his brother Andrew, and James and his brother John; Philip;

Bartholomew; Matthew; Thomas; James son of Alphaeus; Simon, who was called the Zealot; Judas

son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor.

Acts of the Apostles: Peter and John, and James and Andrew, Philip; Thomas; Bartholomew; Matthew; James son of

Alphaeus; Simon the Zealot; Judas son of James; and Matthias, chosen to take the place of Judas

Iscariot who betrayed the Lord.

## **POPE JOHN PAUL I - 1912 - 1978**

On Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> September, Pope Francis will canonise Pope John Paul I, affectionately known as 'The Smiling Pope', who was Pope in 1978 for 33 days. Elected Pope on August 26<sup>th</sup>, he chose the name John Paul to honour his predecessors. To the shock of the world and the Church, he died on September 28<sup>th</sup>. His funeral Mass was held on October 4<sup>th</sup> 1978 – the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi.



The following is taken from the homely given by Pope John Paul I at the Inauguration of his Pontificate September 3<sup>rd</sup> 1978:

"In this sacred celebration, which is the solemn beginning of the ministry which has been placed on our shoulders, the ministry of Supreme Pastor of the Church we first turn our mind in adoration and prayer to the infinite and eternal God.

Our presiding is charity is about service, and in saying this, we are thinking not only of our Catholic brothers and sisters and sons and daughters, but of all those who try to be disciples of Jesus Christ, to love God and to work for the good of humanity."

Pope Saint John Paul I, pray for us that we too for love of God work for the good of humanity.
