"Increase our faith"

READ First Reading: Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4

Responsorial Psalm: O that today you would listen to his

voice! 'Harden not your hearts.' Second Reading: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14

Gospel Reading: Luke 17:5-10

REFLECT: The disciples ask Jesus, "Increase our faith." Elsewhere, Jesus describes his disciples as men of little faith for their reluctance to believe or to understand God's ways. Yet here Jesus helps them to realize the power of even a little faith if we really let it have a impact on our lives. We have to use God's gift to its full potential. That's why Saint Paul write, "fan into a flame the gift of God you received. The image of the flame of faith also appears in the Rite of Baptism, when the priest presents a candle and prays that "these children will keep the flame of faith alive in their hearts." So. It's not so much that Christ has to give us more faith. Rather by cooperating with the Spirit we let the gift of faith we have received become a more effective power in our lives.

RESPOND: "Do not be ashamed, "says Saint Paul. Do not hide your faith in public.

Pray: Meditate upon the gift of faith you have received from God.
