"We should take comfort from our faith."

READ First Reading: Malachi 4:1-2a

Responsorial Psalm: The Lord comes to judge the people with fairness.

Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12

Gospel Reading: Luke 21:5-19

Malachi speaks of God's severe judgement of the unjust and of his comfort to those who have blessed his name. Saint Paul encourages perseverance in a virtuous life. Jesus warns the disciples not to confuse wars and great trials with the end of time. Instead, they are to persevere in their faith and witness.

REFLECT: The kind of world Christ describes sounds very familiar; exactly like the one we live in today, with its wars, revolutions, persecution of Christians and attacks upon Christian values. Christ foresaw that there would be obstacles and difficulties for all those who desire to follow him, but, he wants us to keep following him through it all. "By your patient endurance you will save your souls," says the Lord. The purpose of our comfort from our faith, but that comfort is not to shield us from the world or the problems we face. Through our prayer may we experience the healing and comforting of God, so that we might preserve in facing future trials with hope in him.

RESPOND: Visit a sick relative or friend to bring God's comfort.

Our Night shelter season is nearly upon us again. This year we will be hosting from 31 Dec. every Wed night through to 3 March. Marian will issue more information and details for how to volunteer shortly. Meanwhile, another way to support NewWay is to support their fundraising initiatives below. Last year they raised £11K. Join them this year in one of two ways: Secure a Sleep Spot: We ask all participants who are sleeping out with us to commit to raise between £150 and £250. You can do this as an individual or on behalf of your business, organisation or group. There is a £20 registration fee to secure your sleep spot. (If you secure a sleep spot, you are automatically able to join in with the quiz, you do not need to book a quiz spot). Secure a Quiz Spot: Want to take part in our evening quiz but leave before we bed down for the night? Secure a quiz spot! If you are part of a guiz team, each individual will need to book a quiz spot if you're coming on your own, no fear, we will link you with a team. There is a £10 registration fee to secure your quiz spot. The quiz will take place from 8:30pm-9:15pm on Friday evening. All the money raised goes towards supporting those who are experiencing homelessness at the NEWway Project. The Big Newham Sleep Out 2025 is not designed to replicate someone's experience of sleeping on the streets but is to raise awareness about, and funds for, our work. There will be activities throughout the evening including dinner, a quiz, games and testimonies from those who have experienced the real thing. Breakfast on Saturday morning will be provided for all who sleep over. You can book
