BAPTISM OF THE LORD

11 January 2026

First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4,6-7

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord will bless his people with peace.**

Second Reading: Acts 10:34-38

Gospel: Matthew 3:13-17

REFLECTION

Even before John meets Jesus, he has been proclaiming a figure far superior to him, whose sandal straps he is unworthy to untie. Thus, he cannot image this exalted Judge of the end-time, the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit, lining up with the crowds for his water baptism of repentance. But this *solidarity with sinners*, though shocking to John, is the way to fulfill all *righteousness*. The biblical sense of "righteousness" or "justice" is a far cry from how we understand and experience those terms in the 21st century. In this Gospel passage, all righteousness refers to everything that has been prophesied about God's saving acts, or how God makes right the relationship between the divine and the human. In his Beloved Son Jesus, God takes the definitive step to reach out to us by descending progressively in our world, into our flesh, into our woundedness, and into the abyss of our sinfulness to draw us out of it and restore us to our true identity.

PRAYER

Lord Jesus, through your baptism, you entered into profound solidarity with us, revealing the mercy of God in our midst. Thank you for unveiling the compassionate heart of the Father. Amen
